As stated by Cardinal Timothy Dolan, "We have failed to equip our young people and ourselves with the art of credibly, convincingly, and compellingly defending and presenting our beloved faith. Apologetics prepares us to survive a rational criticism of our faith that is all over the place today. We need it more than ever."

CAINA's popular apologetics presentations include:

The first two presentations provide "the rest of the story" on the actual harmony between science and faith, contrary to the prevailing modern myth that they conflict. The third presentation discusses how medical studies of near-death experiences reveal the reality of our soul and the afterlife, while the fourth highlights the importance of the Holy Eucharist and provides an overview of the amazing findings of scientific studies of several Eucharistic miracles.
